SUMMARY

The Elevator Lead leads day-to-day activities for the elevator to ensure compliance with all applicable legal and regulatory requirements in accordance with established company policies and procedures while maintaining the highest possible levels of safety, quality and productivity.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may

be assigned.

Is responsible for a variety of support and service functions including:

- 1. Must be knowledgeable of Railroad switching and proper handling of rail car air and hand brake systems and couplers
- 2. Must be able to operate the switch to engine to safely and smoothly move cars to and from pre-loading position. Operations of the engine includes various p.m. checks before operations
- 3. Must probe inbound wheat shipments following specified standards while maintaining sample identity
- 4. Prepares a proper track line-up daily



- 5. Operates a computerized system to select proper bins for unloading and transfer of wheat and starting and stopping proper equipment
- 6. Must operate a computerized scale system for proper weighing of inbound wheat. Maintains proper records on scale tickets and inbound car sheets
- 7. Operate wheat cleaning equipment. Establishes proper flow from selected bins. Checks various wheat cleaning machines for proper adjustments
- 8. Performs p.m. checks and lubrications
- 9. Adjusts equipment as possible. Reports other problems to maintenance
- 10. Responsible to maintain critical spare parts inventory and report status to management
- 11. Track conditions and issues of all bucket leg protection devices
- 12. Monitors air filtration equipment for proper operation and changes socks as required
- 13. Monitor inventory in all wheat and mill feed and screening bins. Operate Hammermill and monitor its proper operations
- 14. Responsible for housekeeping throughout the elevator area inside and out
- 15. Responsible to adhere to budget of elevator set by plant management
- 16. Perform other duties or tasks as required

QUALIFICATIONS to perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

EDUCATION

Should have high school education and be able to perform simple mathematical calculations to compute weights and inventories

EXPERIENCE

Must have worked in the elevator and gained understanding of wheat qualities and cleaning procedures and operations of railroad equipment

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Must be able to lift and carry up to 100 pounds
- 2. Must be able to climb ladders and work at heights up to 150 feet
- 3. Must be able to remain on his/her feet for long periods
- 4. Must be able to bend and stoop to reach out of the way places to clean and/or collect samples
- 5. Must not have allergies to wheat and/or associated dusts
- 6. Make sure to inspect machinery before operating them.
- 7. When operating heavy machinery make sure to be aware of the dangers of the equipment.
- 8. Make sure wear personal protective equipment when on the job (this includes harnesses when climbing).

REASONING ABILITY

Must be able to understand and follow through with detailed spoken and/or written instructions and relay them accurately to others

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Must be able to reason through many situations to analyze problems on the mill and correct them on his/her own.

Must be able to provide supervision and make reliable decisions for those under his/her supervision. On second and third shift, this includes the entire plant

WORKING CONDITIONS

Must be able to work in hot, dusty, humid environments and cold wet environments on occasion

SAFETY

- 1. While performing the essential job functions, the employee is expected to work in a safe manner and follow company policies regarding safety.
- 2. It is the expectation and responsibility of the employee to report any and all injuries immediately to the Team Leader, and to report to supervision any safety situation that the employee feels is substandard and poses a risk for employee injury, property damage, or loss.

TEAMWORK
